Jubilee Trees




RECEPTION PLACES SEPTEMBER 2022



A reminder that applications opened on 1 October 2021 and the national closing date is (11:59PM) on 15 January 2022.

It is important that you apply on time as any applications received after the 15 January 2022 will be classed as late applications and will be processed after the national offer day of 19 April 2022. Late applicants are less likely to be offered a Place at any of their preferred school. Click here to apply online.

Along with attendance, punctuality is key to school success for children. As you may be aware, the law treats some persistent lateness in the same way as irregular attendance and parents may be prosecuted by the Local Authority if late arrival is not resolved.

As a parent/carer of a child of statutory school age, you have a legal responsibility to ensure full time education suitable to the child's age, ability and aptitude and any special educational needs the child may have, either by regular attendance at school or otherwise. (Education Act 1996)

What do we define as being late?

- 1. School doors are closed at 8:50am and registration time is 8:55am. After this time, children are classed as arriving 'late' and must report to the office, where names are recorded and the appropriate code added to the class electronic register on Arbor.
- 2. A letter is sent to parents of children who have arrived late three times.
- 3. If further periods of lateness occur parents are invited into school to meet with the attendance coordinator.
- 4. The attendance coordinator monitors punctuality on a regular basis. The impact of letters/meetings is evaluated over time.
- 5. Persistent lateness after the registers close will be dealt with by the attendance coordinator and the head teacher in liaison with the Local Authority.

Poor punctuality can lead to your child...

- Feeling embarrassed in front of their friends
- Missing the beginning of vital lessons
- Missing important instructions for the rest of the school day
- Learning bad habits which could affect their employability in the future

If you are finding it difficult to get your child to school on time, please contact us as there are many ways in which school can help you. If you have other concerns about your child or other difficulties you would like support with, please contact the school who may be able to assist in the form of an Early Help Assessment.




Hot Chocolate Friday!
