
## YEAR 7 SCHOOL APPLICATIONS



In Year 2, we have been looking at Aboriginal art and exploring with clay and patterns to create 3D animals including a lizard, turtle and snake.










In Year 3, we have been looking at South America, focusing on Mexico and the Day of the Dead. We have explored with patterns and collage to create 3D


