



A reminder that applications opened on 1 October 2021 and the national closing date is (11:59PM) on 15 January 2022.

It is important that you apply on time as any applications received after the 15 January 2022 will be classed as late applications and will be processed after the national offer day of 19 April 2022. For children to achieve their very best, it is important they are in school on time every day. Seasonal illness has affected attendance over the past few weeks and we want to work together to improve whole school attendance to reach the national expectation of 97%.

To recognise children with excellent attendance, we will be awarding bronze, silver and gold badges. Every child with attendance and punctuality of 97% or above for a whole term will earn a badge. The first term they achieve this, they will earn a bronze badge, the second term a silver badge and if they have attendance of 97% or above for all 3 terms, they will achieve the gold badge. This means that children have 3 opportunities to achieve badges and 1 period of absence does not prevent children earning their badges throughout the rest of the school year.



The excitement doesn't stop here! Any child who earns a badge in a term will be entered into our termly raffle to win a fantastic large prize—previous winners have received a bike or scooter of their choice!

It is our commitment to all our families to support excellent attendance and punctuality and we are delighted that the vast majority are regularly here and on time. We thank you for your support. We understand that from time to time your child is ill and may need to remain at home however, whilst monitoring attendance and punctuality, we have noticed that attendance for a minority of families is significantly lower than we would hope for and in some cases, less than 90%. This impacts seriously on the children's education. Therefore those families will have received a letter this week to highlight their child's attendance percentage and to offer them support to improve this. If you have received a letter and would like to access this support or if you have any queries or questions about attendance and punctuality, please speak to me on the playground or call the school office to make an appointment. Together we can all be attendance heroes!
