

We love reading at Green Meadow and we will be celebrating World Book Day in school on Thursday, 6th March.

The children are invited to come to school dressed in the clothes they love to read in or bring in three items which represent their favourite book or character.

There will be a number of activities taking place throughout the day. We will start the day with a World Book Day assembly for Key Stage One and Key Stage Two. Children will have the opportunity to visit the school library, create a reading mood board and fortune teller and take part in the World Book Day 2025: The Great Big Footy & Booky Quiz.

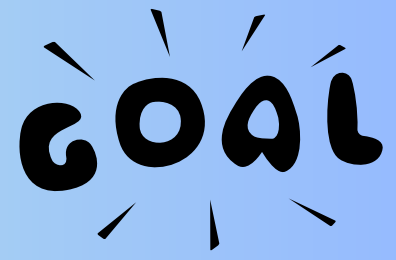

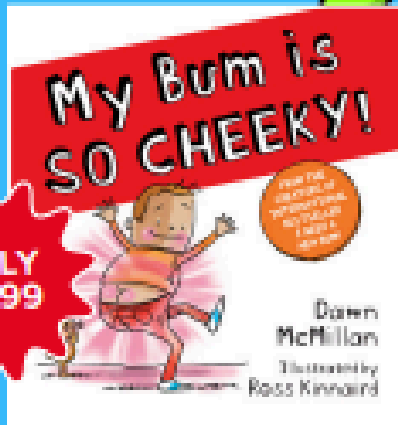

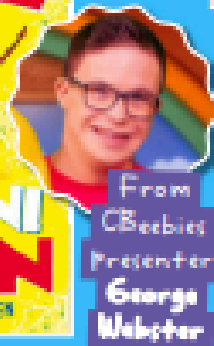
