Dear Parents

As you will be aware from the letter we sent home yesterday, school will be partially closed on Wednesday, 1st February following confirmation from the NEU that members of the union intend to strike on that day. School will be open for all pupils in Year 6 but closed for all other year groups. Remote learning will be made available for all children in Reception to Year 5 and we will send further details about how to access this on Monday.

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The topics are now in full swing and yesterday, we had a MAT curriculum review from the Deputy CEO of Excelsior and Curriculum lead who both said what a privilege it was to be in lessons at Green Meadow. They highlighted how exciting the curriculum at school is and how well the teachers make learning exciting and engage children in their learning. They were really impressed by the beautiful presentation they saw in the books that they looked at. A highlight of their day was speaking with the children. Their oracy skills shone through and they were able to talk in depth about how their current learning builds on previous learning. This is something we are all very proud of and a great example of one of our MAT cornerstones, 'Engaging Learning: unlocking minds every day'.

On Wednesday, the children in Year 4 took part in a fabulous history workshop about the Greeks. They did a shield drill, tried on replica Greek armour and took part in a re-enactment of the Trojan War on the Key Stage 2 playground. You may even have heard their battle cries if you live near school!

Wednesday also saw our largest ever choir take part in the Young Voices Concert at Resorts World Arena. There were almost 7000 children there in total rasing the roof and having the time of their lives taking part in this special event. It will be something we will all remember forever. Thank you to Miss Bonner and Mrs Smith for leading choir this year and thanks too to Mrs Cross, Mrs White and Mr Brooks (if you see him, please ask him to show you his amazing dance moves!) for making this all possible and for surviving Thursday on very little sleep!

Please drop off any items you have at school inside the bike shed in the KS2 playground when you drop off or collect your child.






Young Voices Concert Wednesday 25th January 2023
