


ORACY WEEK AT GREEN MEADOW

Next week is Oracy Week at Green Meadow. Each year group will be practising their Oracy skills throughout the week ending in an outcome or performance on Thursday or Friday. The outcomes will be linked to the topics that children have studied since the beginning of term. In Year 1, children will be learning how to persuade people to go to Africa; in Year 2, children will be creating a David Attenbrough style presentation informing about their favourite dinosaur; in Year 3, children will be creating a presentation to present to children in KS1 informing them about the Amazon rainforest and persuading them to stop deforestation; in Year 4, children will be performing a Greek play; in Year 5 children will hold a class debate and try to persuade the 'witan' on who should become the new king after William the Conqueror and in Year 6, children will be writing and performing their own speech, inspired by Martin Luther King's 'I have a dream' speech, on what equality means to them.

We will also be launching 'Oracy at lunchtime' whereby our Green Meadow talk ambassadors from Years 5 and 6 will be helping to facilitate conversation amongst the younger children after they have had their lunch using discussion starters such as 'Would you rather..?' and 'Have you ever..?', as well as promoting respectful talk with everyone in our school community at lunchtime.

Please make some time to ask your children what Oracy skills they have used throughout the week. We hope the children enjoy creating their outcomes and we look forward to sharing photos throughout the week. Check twitter and next week's newsletter to find out more.


We have got lots of great ideas to share with you so you can support your child in preparation for their times tables test later in the year.
