Dear Parents and Carers,
It has been a fabulous start to the year in Cadbury and Bournville. The children have settled well in KS2 and are focused on their learning already!

This term, our topic is the very exciting history topic, 'The Roman Invasion'.



We will find out all about Roman soldiers and why they chose to invade Britain. We will imagine what it would have been like to be a soldier and discover what their lives were like. We will also learn all about Boudicca and how she led the resistance in Britain.



All of our writing this term will be based on our topic. This will include a mythical narrative, a newspaper report based on Boudicca, a persuasive speech and a diary entry from the perspective of a Roman soldier.

Home Learning in Year 3

Spending a little time each day supporting your child with home learning can really make a difference as well as making sure they build on the learning they have done in school each day. During the Autumn Term, weekly home learning will include spellings, reading for between 10–15 minutes each night as well as starting to learn our multiplication facts in maths.
