What a brilliant start to the year it has been in Jupiter and Pluto. The children have been quick to settle and focus on their learning. Well done, everyone!

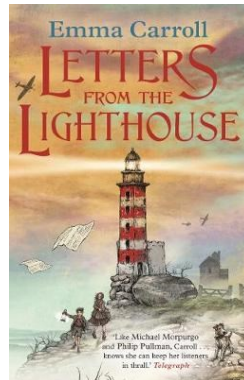

Home Learning in Year 6
