Dear Parents and Carers,

There's been a buzz of excitement around school this week as this term's topics have been launched in all year groups. To give you a little flavour of what the children will be learning, you will all receive an email with a curriculum letter attached from your child's class teacher today and all of the children will also come home tonight with a Knowledge Organiser. The children have been sharing these in class as they are packed full of fascinating facts and key information as well as the vocabulary that the children will need to understand throughout their topic. There are also plenty of ideas for home learning for your child to have a go at at home. A great way to support your child's learning at home is to spend some time each week looking at the information on the Knowledge Organiser to see what they can remember and explain and to have a go at one of the home learning ideas - they are great fun to do and it is always so exciting to see how creative the children are when they bring their home learning to school to share with everyone!

This year, to enhance our already exciting curriculum even more, we have added an additional topic into each year group. This means that each year group will focus on four topics throughout the year, with each one lasting 8 weeks. Two of the topics will be geography based and two will be history based. This will enable the children to learn about an even wider range of exciting topics and deepen their knowledge and understanding of each of these subjects even more. Throughout the year, during each topic, we have a wide range of experiences, trips, visitors and workshops planned as well as trips to our very own VR room! 
