CELEBRATING GREAT LEARNING!



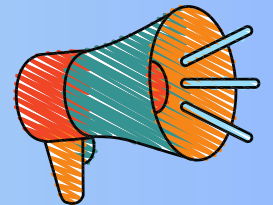
